



Understand Your Responsibility to Report

Designated Reporters

are required under **GW's Title IX Sexual Harassment and Related Conduct Policy**

to share any information learned about suspected or alleged **sexual harassment, sexual assault, stalking, or dating or domestic violence**

with **GW's Title IX Coordinator.**

Who is a Designated Reporter?

GW Faculty

GW Academic Advisors

All staff in Enrollment Management, Student Affairs, ODECE, and HR

Anyone at GW who directly supervises students, student workers, faculty, or other staff

Make a report of **sexual harassment** to GW's Title IX Office by calling 202.994.7434 or by scanning the QR code.



Make a report of **abuse and/or neglect of a minor** to GWPD. For emergencies, call 202.994.6111. For non-emergencies, call 202.994.6110.

Who must report under the Protection of Minors Policy?

Every member of the university community.

Note: under DC law, all members of the university community are considered **mandatory reporters** for the purpose of child (under 16) sexual abuse. Contact MPD and/or DC CFSA immediately upon learning of child sexual abuse.

All Members of the GW Community

are required under **GW's Protection of Minors Policy**

to share any known, suspected, or received information indicating that a **minor has been or is being abused or neglected**

with **GWPD.**
